

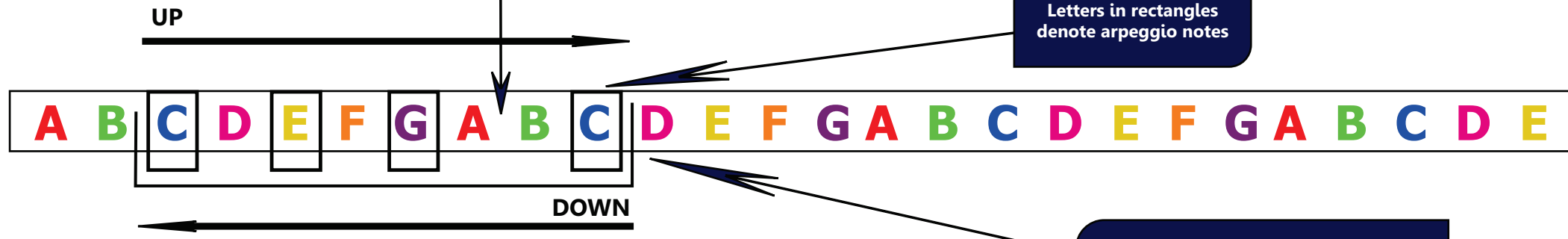
Introduction:

C Major / One Octave:

Use of musical alphabet takes the mystery out of scale structure

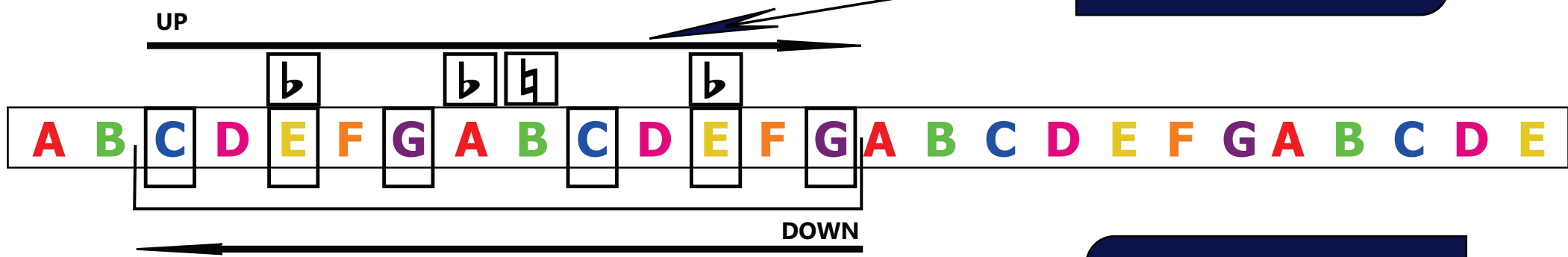
Travel back down the same way you go up

Letters in rectangles denote arpeggio notes



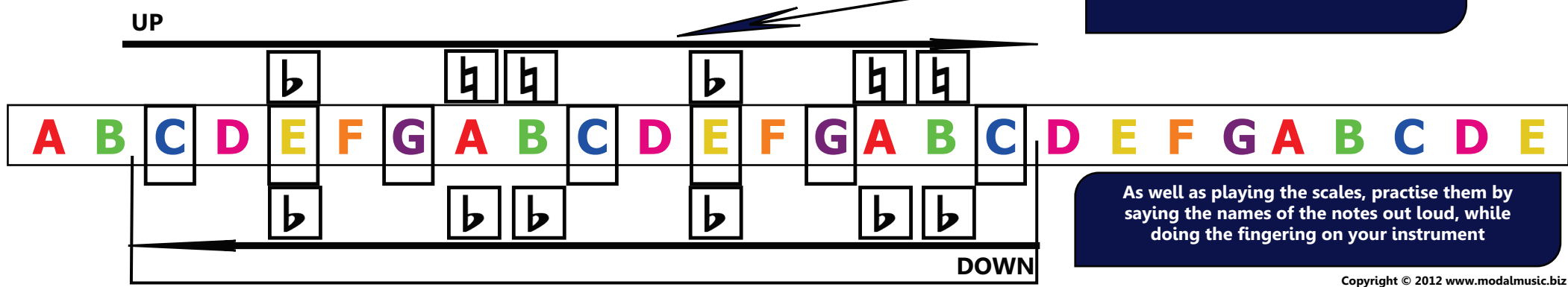
C Minor Harmonic / Twelfth:

Scales that are the same both ascending & descending have the accidentals above the musical alphabet line



C Minor Melodic / 2 Octaves:

Melodic minor scales have the accidentals above the musical alphabet (for ascending) & below (for descending)



As well as playing the scales, practise them by saying the names of the notes out loud, while doing the fingering on your instrument
